October 14th

17:00 - 23:00 Conference Bus Transfer

17:00 - 21:00 Unformal Gathering at Kaffi Klara & Pálshús Museum

Happy Hour at Kaffi Klara, art exhibition & Light Dinner for those who are hungry after their travels. Pálshús Museum hosts the Natural Museum of Ólafsfjörður and a wonderful exhibition called „The Desire to Fly“.

October 15th through 19th

10:00 - 14:30 Visit to University of Akureyri with City Sightseeing – EUR 145,00

20:00 - 22:00 Welcoming Reception at The Herring Museum Siglufjörður.

22:00 - 00:00 Northern Lights Mystery – EUR 69,00

Being out in the dark, frozen winter night and observing the unbelievable display of color, light and texture, is like waking up in a fairy-tale, full of mystery and magic.

The Northern Lights tour is a one of a kind Northern Lights hunt experience. After all participants have been picked up at their hotels we will drive to the countryside or up to the mountains, away from electric glow and city sounds. You will be able to enjoy the beautiful night sky at the best possible situation, of course depending on weather. The Northern Lights, or the Aurora Borealis, are a natural phenomenon visible in the Northern Hemisphere. If so happens that we will not be able to spot them due to weather, the guests can go on the Northern Lights tour again next evening.

October 16th

16:00 - 18:30 Icelandic Culture Walk – EUR 39,00

On this tour we will walk through the town, Ólafsfjörður, and visit a small market that sells traditional wool products and other designs, made by local handcraft artists and a fish factory where you get to taste smoked salmon and other goods. And before we end the trip by jumping into the Geothermal Pool, a local Micro Brewery will visit us with products for tasting.

17:00 - 18:30 Nordic Sea Swimming - EUR 35,00

It is cold but an amazing experience. Our gym teacher, Lísá, will take you for a Sea Swimming class just like our students experience in their gym classes. And to warm you up again, Lísá invites you to her Outdoor Jacuzzi where you will have a chance to taste homemade Icelandic Liqueur.

20:30 - 22:00 Traditional Icelandic “Kvöldvaka”

“Kvöldvaka” is a gathering where Icelanders come together to entertain themselves with guitars, singing and dancing.

October 17th

15:00 - 18:30 Arctic Whale Watching - EUR 95,00

After hotel pick up, we head straight to Dalvík from where we sail out. Whale watching is an activity you should not miss out on! You have an exceptionally good chance to encounter the great humpback whale in this area and white-beaked dolphins, minke whales, the small harbor porpoises and sometimes even the majestic blue whale are also often spotted. Overall we have seen whales or dolphins in 98% of our whale watching tours. The whale watching tour is built up as an adventure. So with an excellent chance of seeing whales you can also expect more fun with fishing and tasting of the freshly caught cod, haddock, pollock or atlantic catfish in the picturesque landscape of Eyjafjörður just short off the Arctic Circle.

15:30 - 17:30 Arctic Coastline & Fjords - EUR 89,00

After hotel pick up, we head through the valley of fjord Ólafsfjörður and over the highland with breathtaking nature sights. On our way back we drive the Arctic Coastline Tröllaskagi peninsula and visit a Geothermal Water Source Station to have Icelandic „kleina“ and hot cocoa .

October 18th

19:00 - 23:00 Festive Dinner at Restaurant Rauðka

Rauðka will take us on a gastronomic journey while we enjoy great local entertainment. Singing and dancing will be involved, so remember to bring your appetite as well as your festive spirit.
